

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

#### **5.1 Conclusion**

Based on the results of research data analysis regarding the Effect of the Learning Environment on the Writing Ability of Class X Students of SMA Imelda Medan, we can draw conclusions from the analysis using a simple linear regression coefficient (t test), on the acquisition of the results of hypothesis testing by comparing the probability values (0, 05) with a significant value of 0.001. Meanwhile, based on hypothesis testing by comparing the t-count and t-table values, the t-count is 3.737 and the t-table is 2.026, as well as the SPSS calculation, the coefficient of determination (R-square) is 0.274, which implies that the effect of the independent variable (Learning Environment) on related variables (Writing Ability) is 27.4%. So it can be concluded that  $H_0$  is rejected and  $H_a$  is accepted, that is, there is a significant effect of learning environment on the writing ability of the tenth graders of SMA Imelda Medan.

##### **1. Teachers**
