# CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1. Background of The Study

In Indonesia, English is one of the international languages which plays an important role in education, Junior high school students learning English serves as a self-development tool for students of science, technology, and the arts.

The aim of teaching and learning English in junior high school are, that students know when to use English Song, how to pronounce words and phrases, and at least to help students learn more and understand about language features. Knowledge of English helps facilitate more comprehensive information retrieval, English is needed to be learned, because it has an important role in everyday life, especially in the world of education. For students, English is one of the most commonly used international languages. In other words, English is needed as a means of communication with people all over the world.

According to brown (2001), the importance of listening is "listening is the major component in language learning and teaching because in the classroom learners do more listening than speaking." Oxford Rugby League (1993) says that "listening is a creative skill". Thus we arrange a structure of language into a perfect part (Oxford, 1993: 21).

Teachers should choose a method or strategy that takes into account the child's preferences. In this way, the teacher not only communicates content and materials to her, but also uses media. One of her best tools for learning and teaching listening is singing.

Songs are known by all of her as a medium to help students easily memorize her words while learning English. You may ask students to memorized the words and say them out loud. It can be fun too.

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Currently English songs are very popular to students, that are often heard everywhere, especially on social media which currently cannot be separated from children or students, both from Instagram, YouTube, and other media. English songs have become a daily intake, with a lot of listening to English, children automatically remember the words in the song, and if they like it, sometimes they look for meaning in various media, English songs have a very big influence on hearing as well as to increase student vocabulary.

Researchers found several obstacles at MTS S Islamiyah Gunting Saga, in terms of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade listening to English, the problems that the researchers found

were; the first, students do not get the material, so sometimes there is a misunderstanding of the material, many students are bored in listening class because the teacher presents learning using conventional techniques, so students feel not interested in the topic being discussed. The second, the lack of vocabulary, because students have little accepted vocabulary in their memorization, it happens that they rarely practice listening to English.

By using songs, Students can teach themselves to speak English fluently by employing songs to help them learn as if they were speaking or listening to native speakers directly. Because there are problems in Learning English for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade of MTS Islamiyah Gunting Saga, In particular, the researcher observes many students who do not brave to understand English because they lack of vocabulary in listening and their believe that English still not is not substantial and arduos.

The students never learn English for enjoyment and find it enjoyable to memorized and know about English in context with the other friends, they lack the motivation to understand English. They also struggle to write words after listening to the test. Additionally, it appears that teachers continue to adopt boring instructional methods. Considering the previous claim, this research takes the title "The Effect of English Song as Media on Students Listening Comprehension Mastery in Class VIII MTs IslamiyahGunting Saga". The selected songs are songs made by native speakers and how to improve students' listening skills.
