Associated with speaking, linguistic knowledge has an important role for speaking skills. Indonesians have difficulty in mastering speaking skills because everyday Indonesian is not English. (Robinson and Ellis 2008: 426) stated that speaking is still considered the most difficult skill owned by most English students, and they still do not have good competence in Indonesia communicate in English. There are a number of difficulties students may face in speaking English. described the difficulties caused by lack of vocabulary, pronunciation, and grammar. Because English is recognized as a foreign language in Indonesia, it makes Indonesian students become difficult to speak English fluently. revealed that students' speaking skills low in Indonesia. This is caused by lack of vocabulary and grammar knowledge. Grammar knowledge is one of the most important aspects of being a professional in speaking skills. English grammar is different from grammar in

Indonesian. Based on the explanation above, speaking is an important skill, however students have grammatical problems to master speaking skills. In addition, (Astrid 2011: 108) stated that Indonesian students sometimes easily mention the rules of English grammar but when they are dealing with applying that skill in speaking, it will be very difficult for them. Therefore in the discussion of this study the researcher will discuss any difficulties experienced by third-grade of senior high school students in speaking skill and what are the factors causing these difficulties.
