## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION, IMPLICATION, AND SUGGESTION

## 5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of research and discussion, it can be concluded that:

The difference in average scores between the experimental class and the control class also shows that there are significant differences in student scores in learning English using Student Worksheets (LKS) and without LKS. It shows that here is a significant difference in the average scores between the experimental class and the control class. The average scores in the experimental class are 82.63 with a standard deviation of 12.614. While the average scores in the control class is 73.03 with a standard deviation of 13.433. Therefore, it can be concluded that LKS is used effectively to teach English without LKS given the difference in mean scores between the experimental class and the control class.

## 5.2 Implication

Research implications can be made from the results of the study. This study found that there was an effectiveness of using worksheets in teaching English compared to using conventional methods in the teaching and learning process. Thus, worksheets are considered as good and creative learning media needed in learning English. The students are interested and motivated to learn through LKS because they can practice their ability to work on the questions in it.

By implying student worksheets as learning media for students to make students more focused on learning, especially in the 2013 curriculum, currently many subject matter presented is very difficult so that it cannot be resolved properly by students.

## 5.3 Suggestion

Suggestions that can be submitted based on the research that has been done are as follows.

- 1. For readers, related parties or future researchers, this research should become valuable information for researchers in the field of English, especially on the use of student worksheets in learning English.
- 2. For teachers, it is better to use student worksheets (LKS) in learning English. Student worksheets are used in English subjects because it can maximize student learning outcomes through systematic steps. Things to consider in using student worksheets (LKS) in learning English are:
  - a. If facilities such as student books are not available at school, it can be overcome by providing teaching materials to students.
  - b. If the number of students in the class is too many, it can be overcome by good classroom management, namely by 78/127 conditioning students to stay focused on learning activities, manage time well during learning and understand learning material in depth and relate it to real life.

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
