

CHAPTER V

CLOSING

This chapter contains conclusions from the discussions that have been carried out in the previous chapter and contains suggestions from researchers for readers.

5.1 Conclusion

There are still many students who experience communication skills problems when asked to speak in front of the class. many students are not motivated to improve their communication skills in order to perform well in front of the class. In addition, the main obstacle is students who do not dare or are afraid to make mistakes. students are afraid to appear in front of the class because they are not used to doing this. Then, the teacher also rarely invites students to communicate or asks students to do public speaking. the same as the results that have been carried out at SMP N 5 Panyabungan.

So, based on the results of research and discussion, researchers concluded that there were several problems of communication skills in public speaking classes experienced by students and the reasons.

First, the problems faced by students are the poor grammar. Second, lack of intonation. Third, lack of body movement. And the last one can not speak loud.

And the reason why students have these problems is because of the lack of vocabulary which makes grammar terrible and makes the story conveyed incomprehensible to the audience. Second, lack of practice or lack of pronunciation. Third, the panic that students so that students remain silent and do not make body movements such as eye contact with the audience. And the last, lack of confidence. Students feel inferior when communicating in front of the class and make loud noises.

The essence of the above conclusion is that students who experience communication skill problems in public speaking class and the reasons why they

experience these problems. Students are expected to be able to overcome problems and be able to improve their communication skills well.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusions above, it is recommended that students be more confident in communicating. Then, it will be better if the student program joins with English clubs so that practice keeps them regular and makes them speak and communicate fluently and well. Students must study hard and do more practice speaking because it is the key to being able to communicate in English, students should not be ashamed to express their ideas, and students should not be afraid to make mistakes. To teacher, the teacher must provide motivation and stimulating students' opinions are very important to increase students' attention in communicating using English. Teachers must be able to make teaching and the learning process become fun.
