A. Conclusion

Based on analyzing data, the researcher finds that there are some impacts of Blended Learning on student's speaking ability. And in this study there are six findings on this study that we got, namely: students did not have partner to speak English, the assignments and exercises given are not enough to improve student's speaking, students lack in motivation to speak English, missing or lack memorized vocabularies, students are not focussed on studying and there is no increase or even decrease on grade and learning process for students.

B. Recommendation

2. For the teacher

2.2 The teacher should search more information about the strategies or method how to teach speaking English. It can make the student's interest in speaking English and it will overcome the problem of the students face in speaking English.

2.3 Teachers must be aware of students' problems in blended learning and teaching speaking also provide motivation in learning speaking English.

3.1 The researcher suggest other researchers to dig deeper about the impact of blended learning on students speaking ability and how to solve it.
