

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CLOSING**

In this chapter, the researcher presented some conclusions from the result of the research, in order to make the readers more understand about the findings of this study:

#### **2.1 Conclusion**

Based on the research and discussion, it can be concluded that:

- a. The score of male students in reading comprehension at the Eighth grade of MTS YAPI BKAI SEI KARANG is 7,09 which classified as “Fairly Good”.
- b. The score of female students in reading comprehension at the Eighth grade of MTS YAPI BKAI SEI KARANG is 7,9 which classified as “Good”
- c. There is no significant difference between male and female students in reading comprehension at the Eighth grade of MTS YAPI BKAI SEI KARANG. It can be concluded by seeing the result of t-test that the researcher has provided on table 4.8 that  $t_{count} = -17,1249$  and  $t_{table} = 2,000298$ . Because  $t_{count} < t_{table}$ , it can be concluded  $H_0$  is accepted and  $H_a$  is rejected. Therefore, it can be said that there is no significant difference between male and female in reading comprehension at eighth grade of MTS YAPI BKAI SEI KARANG.

#### **2.2 Suggestion**

Considering on the result of the research, the researcher would like to propose some suggestion as follows:

- a. It would be better to improve the students' reading proficiency since, according to this study, there are male and female students' reading comprehension were being in the poor level. In order to improve the reading skills of the students, there are a few approaches and strategies that can be applied in teaching and learning activity.

- b. The researcher suggested that students need to improve their reading proficiency not only at school but also with their own will. They need to enrich their vocabularies in order to understand the material easily so that they can answer the question correctly.
