Since 1981, the Humber Bridge in England has been the world's <u>longest-span</u> (1,410 meters) bridge. Like most other <u>long-span</u> bridges, it is a <u>suspension</u> bridge. In a <u>suspension</u> bridge, the bridge deck hangs, or is <u>suspended</u>, from thick steel <u>cables</u>. They are made of tens of thousands of kilometers of thin steel wires <u>bound</u> together.

The <u>cables</u> go up and over tall towers on either side of the <u>gap</u> to be <u>spanned</u>. They are <u>anchored firmly</u> at each end. In the largest <u>suspension</u> bridges, the towers have to be built <u>slightly</u> out of <u>parallel</u> to allow for the curve of the Earth!

Tenants advised to obey regulations on apartment

Jakarta: A building <u>architect</u> has <u>advised</u> families planning to live in an apartment to study all the <u>relevant regulations prior</u> to moving in to help prevent unexpected <u>security-related occurrences</u>.

"<u>Tenants</u> must obey certain <u>regulations</u> when living in an apartment, which is far different from living in a landed-house," Fendhi Ibuhindar said.

"<u>Tenants</u> of an apartment should <u>abide</u> by <u>regulations</u> set by the owner of the high-rise building," he added.

"This is important, <u>especially</u> for a family that has a young child," he was <u>quoted</u> as saying by okezone.com.

<u>According</u> to him, the <u>trend</u> of living in an apartment in Jakarta started only 10 years ago. Living in an apartment has <u>increasingly</u> become <u>popular</u>.

"Most of Jakarta's <u>residents</u> are more <u>accustomed</u> to living in a landed house and when they live in an apartment, many are not ready for apartmentliving habits and <u>regulations</u>. They have to <u>abandon</u> their <u>mindset</u> of living in a landed-house," he said.

He said that an owner of apartment should also <u>consider</u> <u>aspects</u> of <u>designing</u> and building <u>materials</u> that are safe for children. "The <u>quality</u> of building <u>materials</u> should be <u>prioritized</u>," he said.

"Children's safety should be the <u>main concern</u> with <u>regards</u> to the building <u>materials</u> that are used," he said.

Parents upset, disappointed with online school registration

Hundreds of parents <u>thronged</u> the Jakarta <u>Education Agency's</u> office in Kuningan, South Jakarta, to report <u>problems</u> with the <u>online</u> school <u>registration</u> <u>system</u> on Friday.

During their visit to the agency's office, the parents <u>expressed</u> their <u>dissatisfaction</u> with the <u>online system</u>, which <u>according</u> to them was <u>disorganized</u> and made it <u>difficult</u> for them to <u>register</u> their children for <u>enrollment</u> in public schools.

Riki Setyanto, one of the parents, said that he had <u>registered</u> his daughter for <u>enrollment</u> at state <u>vocational</u> high school SMKN 47 Jakarta, but she then got <u>rejected</u> due to the <u>minimum</u> height policy applied by the state-run school.

However, he added, his daughter was also turned down after she <u>registered</u> at a different school because her name was still listed for SMKN 47 Jakarta.

"First, my daughter was <u>rejected</u> because of her height, and now due to <u>technical issues</u>, she can't <u>register</u> at any school. I just want to get her into a good school," he said, adding that he hoped the <u>agency</u> could <u>solve</u> the <u>problems</u> as soon as possible.

Nuraisyah Paransa, another parent, also said that she was unable to <u>register</u> her son at any state-run high school due to <u>similar technical problems</u>.

She said that her son was <u>initially</u> accepted at East Jakarta public school through public <u>admission phase</u>. However, he did not <u>re-register</u> with that school as he wanted to shoot for a better state-run school through the <u>local admission</u> phase.

"But the second school <u>rejected</u> him because he had been accepted through the public <u>admission phase</u>. Since my son did not <u>re-register</u> at the first school, now he isn't <u>registered</u> anywhere," she said

The <u>online registration system</u> has been <u>applied</u> in the capital since 2004. No such <u>problems occurred</u> with the <u>previous registration system</u>.

This year's student <u>admission</u> <u>system</u> has three <u>phases</u>: public <u>admission</u>, where students <u>vie</u> for seats with other students <u>throughout</u> the country; <u>local</u> <u>admission</u>, where students <u>compete</u> with others in the same <u>province</u>; and third

<u>admission</u>, where students who did not get accepted during first and second <u>admission resubmit</u> their <u>applications</u>.

Lasro Marbun, head of the Jakarta Education Agency, said that anyone who did not <u>re-register</u> in the public <u>admission phase</u> and was unable to <u>register</u> during <u>local admission</u> or third <u>admission</u>, could <u>register</u> their children at <u>private</u> schools.

"They can then <u>transfer</u> them to a public school in the second <u>semester</u>," he said on Thursday as <u>quoted</u> by kompas.com.

However, Rida Afrida, who wanted to <u>register</u> her son at state junior high school SMP 194, did not agree with that idea. <u>According</u> to her, a lot of people have chosen public schools over <u>private</u> schools for <u>financial</u> reasons.

"I cannot pay for a <u>private</u> school, if he thinks that is a good <u>alternative</u> for us, he should just give us the money to pay for those schools," she said.

<u>Meanwhile</u>, acting Jakarta <u>governor</u> Basuki Tjahaja Purnama said that the parents should be <u>patient</u> and not <u>panic</u>.

"We had no <u>problems</u> last year. The <u>process</u> might be a little <u>complicated</u>, but there's no reason to <u>panic</u>," the acting <u>governor</u> told <u>reporters</u> at City Hall. (idb/dwa)



Indonesia Opens Regional Recycling Conference

SURABAYA, INDONESIA - Indonesia has opened a <u>regional recycling</u> <u>conference</u> aimed at <u>increasing awareness</u> of waste <u>management</u> for <u>economic</u> and <u>environmental benefits</u>.

The Fifth <u>Regional</u> 3R <u>Forum</u> in Asia and the Pacific, which opened in Surabaya Tuesday, is being attended by 300 <u>participants</u> from nearly 40 Asia and Pacific countries.

The city was chosen to host the <u>event</u> because of its <u>success</u> in <u>managing</u> <u>municipal</u> waste through the 3Rs, <u>Reduce</u>, <u>Reuse</u>, and <u>Recycle</u>.

Mayor Tri Rismaharini said waste <u>transportation</u> is <u>expensive</u> and that the best way to address the problem is at its <u>sources</u>, with every <u>household involved</u> in <u>recycling activities</u>. "We can see that every year there is a <u>reduction</u> in the <u>volume</u> of <u>trash</u> that ends up in the <u>landfills</u>. When I was the head of Sanitation and Parks, it was 2,300 <u>cubic</u> meters per day. <u>Currently</u> it's 1,200 <u>cubic</u> meters," she explained. "So you can see the <u>reduction</u>, which goes to <u>composting</u> center, also in the <u>community</u>, and waste <u>management</u> centers."

The mayor said the city also runs a program for children called eco school.

"The school does not only teach about the <u>environment</u> but also <u>introduces</u> <u>environmental-friendly</u> <u>practices</u>, such as the eco school <u>program</u> where they bring their own plates and cups to <u>reduce plastic</u> waste. They even don't use drinking straws," added Tri Rismaharini.

The conference will continue until Thrusday.

How to Make Chocolate Dipped Strawberries

To make chocolate dipped strawberries, *first*, prepare all the following <u>ingredients</u>:

- 2 chopped squares <u>semisweet</u> or <u>bittersweet</u> chocolate
- ¹/₂ tablespoon whipping cream
- Dash almond extract
- 8 strawberries

Second, <u>combine</u> the chocolate and the whipping cream in a glass measuring cup or bowl. <u>Microwave</u> at <u>medium</u> power for 1 minute until the chocolate melts, stirring after 30 seconds. Stir in the almond <u>extract</u> and cool <u>slightly</u>.

Finally, dip each strawberry into the melted chocolate, allowing the <u>excess</u> to drip off. Place on a waxed paper-lined baking sheet. <u>Refrigerate</u> of freeze for <u>approximately</u> 15 minutes until the chocolate is set.



Last Saturday, the 12 grade students went for a trip to the botanical garden. Some teachers were also with us. We gathered together in front of the school yard very early in the morning. It took us about two hours by bus to get there from our school.

At the botanical garden, we did several things. First, we bought the <u>entrance</u> ticket. Second, we listened to our teachers' <u>instruction</u> about group <u>activities</u>. Next, we divided ourselves into groups based on our personal <u>interests</u>. Then, each group followed the <u>assigned</u> teacher. We spent the rest of the day with our groups doing a lot of <u>activities</u>. It was really a fun day for us.



Head lice can be treated by wet combing. For it to be <u>effective</u>, wet combing needs to be <u>regular</u> and <u>thorough</u>. These are the steps of wet combing. First, wash the hair using <u>ordinary shampoo</u> and <u>apply</u> plenty of <u>conditioner</u>, before using a wide-toothed comb to straighten and <u>untangle</u> the hair. Second, switch to the <u>louse detection</u> comb. Third, draw the comb down to the ends of the hair with every <u>stroke</u>, and check the comb for lice. Next, remove lice by wiping or <u>rinsing</u> the comb. Then, work <u>methodically</u> through the hair, <u>section</u> by <u>section</u>, so that the whole head is combed through. Finally, <u>rinse</u> out <u>conditioner</u> and repeat the combing <u>procedure</u>. Repeat the <u>procedure</u> on days 5, 9, and 13, so that you clear young lice as they hatch, before they have time to reach <u>maturity</u>.

How to Breed Leopard Geckos

Leopard geckos could be easy to <u>breed</u> for some, but <u>difficult</u> for others. In this <u>article</u>, you will see the simplest way to <u>breed</u> leopard geckos.

Things you'll need:

- 1. Cage for Geckos (20 gallon for two, 10 gallon more for each additional female)
- 2. Laying box (A <u>plastic container</u> filled with damp moss for the <u>female</u> to lay in.)
- 3. Incubation Medium (usually Perlite)
- 4. Lots of crickets dusted with calcium for egg growth
- 5. Very small crickets for the babies

Steps:

1. Get a male and <u>female</u> leopard gecko.

The males have <u>hemipenal bulges</u> below the <u>vent whereas females</u> do not. Males and <u>females</u> both have a V-shaped row of scales above the <u>vent</u> but only the male's scales here are hollow and <u>produce</u> wax. This wax is for <u>scent</u> marking their <u>territory</u>.

2. Prepare a large cage for the male and <u>female</u> to live in together.

Geckos can be kept together without the need to separate them unless you see major <u>aggression</u>. It is sometimes <u>normal</u> when first <u>introducing</u> a male and <u>female</u> for there to be a little <u>squabbling</u>, but this <u>usually</u> stops <u>within</u> the first week. <u>Breeding</u> should <u>occur within</u> a week.

For a pair you will need at least a 20 gallon long tank. You may also choose to house one male with 4-5 <u>females</u>; add 10 gallons of space for each additional gecko.

If you see major <u>drama</u>/fighting, separate the pair. You'll want to <u>confirm</u> they are not both males. If one male and one <u>female</u>, you can <u>reintroduce</u> them again later.

3. Get the incubator ready for the eggs and provide a lay box.

You can use a <u>plastic</u> sandwich <u>container</u> with a lid for this <u>purpose</u>. Cut an <u>entry</u> hole on one side and fill it with damp moss (This can be used as the <u>moist</u> hide too).

4. Ready the laying box to put in the cage.

Females dig to lay their eggs, so you will provide a place for them to dig. In

about 4 to 5 weeks, the <u>female</u> will lay her eggs. <u>Normally</u>, you will see her digging in the laying box and laying the eggs in pairs. It will be easy to tell she has laid the eggs, <u>particularly</u> since she will be much thinner.

5. Place the eggs in the <u>incubation medium</u>.

Remove them from the laying box and be careful not to <u>rotate</u> or <u>jiggle</u> the eggs. After 24 hours of being laid, the <u>embryo</u> inside <u>attaches</u> itself to the side wall of the egg. <u>Rotating</u> or <u>jiggling</u> this egg could cause the <u>embryo</u> to come loose and drown inside, killing it. If you want girls, set the <u>incubation</u> <u>temperature</u> 80 to 85 <u>degrees</u>; if you want males, set the <u>temperature</u> 90 to 95 <u>degrees</u>, and if you want a mix, set the <u>temperature</u> in the middle!

6. Observe the developing embryos.

After a few weeks you will be able to "candle" the eggs using a small flashlight. You don't have to touch the eggs, just take them into a dark room and shine the light as close to the shell as you can. You should see pink inside with red blood vessels. The further along the eggs are, the more you will also see the <u>baby</u> inside as a dark <u>mass</u>. After around 60 days, give or take depending on the <u>incubation temperature</u>, the eggs should hatch.

7. Have tiny <u>crickets</u> readily <u>available</u>.

<u>Babies</u> will start eating insects within a day or two of being hatched.

If you watch people bathing dogs in movies and <u>TV</u> shows, most of the time it seems like a joyous, fun-filled time for all <u>involved</u>. <u>Unfortunately</u>, bathing your dog in real life isn't always such a <u>positive experience</u>.

Dogs do not mind being dirty and <u>stinky</u> — in fact, they like it quite a bit — and many are not afraid to put up a fight if they think that it will help them get out of bath time. And while watching a favorite <u>actor</u> run after a dog covered in soap <u>suds</u> may seem hilarious, it's a lot less fun when you have to do it — or your dog is <u>wrestling</u> and clawing to get as far away as possible from you.

Here are our tips for how to wash a dog that will make it a much more friendly <u>experience</u> for both you and your pup.

Power of **positive** association

The first thing you want to do, as is true with almost anything new you <u>introduce</u> to your dog, is to tie the bath to something <u>positive</u>. In other words, offer treats, toys, and <u>affection</u> to get your dog to come to the bath, and every time they behave in a way that is helpful during bath time.

Start by getting them used to hopping into an empty tub and just spending time there while you give them treats or toys, and work your way up to adding warm (not hot) water.

Do not be afraid to repeat <u>actions</u> until they truly seem to get it. For <u>example</u>, if you have a dog bathtub or a <u>specific area</u> where you bathe your dog, get them to come to you there and offer a treat every time they obey until they come even without a treat.

Protect the ears

You want to be very careful not to get water into your dog's ears during the bath. Not only is it uncomfortable for them, it's something that can <u>actually</u> cause health <u>problems</u>.

If your dog will let you do it, stuff cotton balls into his ears; if not, simply do your best to <u>avoid spraying</u> water into them.

Start young

If you have a puppy, start bathing her as soon as possible. She'll be less <u>opposed</u> to the <u>experience</u> when she's younger because she won't have any <u>negative</u> <u>associations</u> toward it. By getting her used to it early on, you will <u>encounter</u> less trouble later.

Use the right shampoo

One way to make a bath even more unpleasant for your dog is to pick a <u>shampoo</u> that causes them to scratch or dries their skin out. Ideally you want a <u>mild</u> soap that cleans and removes unwanted <u>odors</u> without stripping away important oils. What is the best way to <u>ensure</u> you are getting the right <u>shampoo</u> for your dog? Talk to your <u>vet</u>.

Work from the neck down

You not only want to keep your dog's ears safe, but also her eyes and mouth. How do you do this? By washing from the neck down. You can <u>accomplish</u> this by using a bucket or cup to wet your dog or using a <u>sprayer</u>. You can even find <u>sprayers specifically designed</u> for bathing a dog. So what do you do to wash your pup's face? Use a damp <u>washcloth</u>.

Dry right

Many people swear by dog blow <u>dryers</u>, but the noise and feel is <u>definitely</u> something that you have to get him used to. Be careful to <u>avoid</u> burning his skin.

The other way to go is to simply towel her off. If you are going to do this, use one of the more <u>absorbent</u> dog towels that can be found at most pet stores. And, of course, be prepared for the <u>inevitable</u> "shake" as your dog dries herself off.

By making pleasant <u>associations</u> with bath time and remaining <u>calm</u> and <u>assertive</u> while you are washing your dog, you can make it another <u>opportunity</u> for <u>bonding</u> and to share <u>affection</u>. Just be patient.

How to **Operate** Photoshop: <u>Tutorial</u> for <u>Beginners</u>

When you open Photoshop for the first time, it's easy to click around in <u>confusion</u> for a minute and then reach for your <u>freelancer's</u> phone number instead. With a little help, you can easily teach yourself how to use it to <u>create</u> beautiful, <u>compelling graphics</u>. All it takes is an <u>introduction</u> to <u>core elements</u>. To get you started, you need to understand how the five most important Photoshop tools work. The five tools are the Layer Tool, the Color & Swatches Tool, the Custom Fonts and the Text Tool, Custom Brushes & the Brush Tool and the Crop Tool.

First, <u>recognize</u> how a layer tool works. A layer can be used for an <u>image</u>, <u>text</u>, brush <u>strokes</u>, background colors, <u>patterns</u>, and <u>filters</u>. Layers are by far the most important <u>element</u> of Photoshop. Always name your layers. Keeping them <u>organized</u> will help keep you <u>sane</u>, <u>especially</u> if you find yourself working on a <u>project</u> with a large number of layers.

With layers, you can select, add, delete, and <u>duplicate</u> them. You can also do all sorts of cool things, such as, making <u>animated</u> pictures.

Then, make sure you know how the Color & Swatches Tool <u>operates</u>. The tool lets you use, <u>modify</u>, copy, and save <u>custom</u> colors for your <u>content</u>. It has powerful <u>features</u> that will keep your <u>visual content</u> <u>vibrant</u> and <u>unify</u> your color <u>schemes</u>. To <u>create</u> your <u>own custom</u> color, open the Color Picker by doubleclicking on the top box either in the Color <u>module</u>, or in that <u>menu</u> on the left. Then, you'll see a <u>vertical spectrum</u> of color with a <u>slider</u> on it, which you can <u>adjust</u> to <u>create</u> your own <u>custom</u> color.

Third, change <u>texts</u> using the Custom Fonts and the Text Tool. The Text Tool lets you adds <u>custom fonts</u> to your <u>database</u>, and it gives you <u>access</u> to <u>advanced font</u> settings that give your <u>text</u> some <u>serious style</u>. Once you click the Text Tool <u>icon</u>, all of the settings and <u>font options</u> will pop up at the top of your screen. These settings let you change the <u>font</u>, <u>font</u> size, and spacing between <u>characters</u>, height, <u>width</u>, color, and <u>style</u>. Be sure to select the <u>layer</u> of your desired <u>text</u> to <u>edit</u> it. To add text to your <u>graphic</u>, click the "T" <u>icon</u> on the left side bar, drag the <u>text</u> box over any particular <u>area</u> you want <u>text</u> to appear, and you're set to go.

Fourth, to <u>achieve</u> a number of different <u>visual</u> <u>effects</u>, change the size, shape, and <u>transparency</u> of your brush <u>stokes</u> using Custom Brushes & the Brush Tool. Once you click the Brush tool <u>icon</u>, all of the settings and brush <u>options</u> will pop up at the top of your screen. These settings let you change the brush size,

<u>opacity</u>, flow, and so on. You'll find a <u>variety</u> of <u>pre-installed</u> brush tips, as well as any <u>custom</u> brush tips you <u>install</u> to Photoshop.

The next tool to use in Photoshop is Crop Tool. The Crop tool lets you crop an <u>image</u>. It works like any crop tool you've ever encountered: simply choose your <u>area</u> and crop it out. To use the Crop tool, select the <u>icon indicated</u> in the <u>screenshot</u> from the side <u>menu</u> bar, and drag the box over the <u>area</u> you would like to crop. To <u>adjust</u> the crop box, simply click and drag the small <u>anchor</u> boxes on the sides and corners of the crop box.
