#### **CHAPTER I**

#### INTRODUCTION

## A. Background of the Study

In Indonesia, English is the first foreign language. Many schools or courses include English as one of the subjects. English has four skills: speaking, reading, listening, and writing, and vocabulary as a component can be used to improve all of these skills. A lack of vocabulary is one of the most common issues students faced when learning and mastering English. Fourth, kids' vocabulary is memorized due to a lack of control. It was easy for them to forget what words they had been taught or learned.

MTs Ubudiyah Pangkalan Brandanis a popular junior high school in Pangkalan Brandan. It is well-known among other schools. That school's quality is good, without a doubt, match its status. In fact, several issues remained, such as the students' capacity to communicate in English. When the researcher taught English there, he discovered that the students' competence was still low, and that increasing their vocabulary would require work. The kids were completely speechless, and it was difficult for them to say or write anything concerning terminology. The researcher did notice, however, that the students have the potential and ability to expand their vocabulary.
