

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the data analysis, the researcher can conclude as follow:

1. There are problems in learning English during Pandemic Covid-19 at the twelfth grade class of SMA N 1 Rantau Utara in Academic Year 2021/2022. The problems in learning English material in Senior High School can be presented by vocabulary, listening, reading, and writing. As for a reason, the students would have difficulty in vocabulary because their lack of vocabulary makes it difficult to understand the meaning of the reading context or language mastery. Listening is unfamiliar with the foreign language, so they did not know what the speaker said. Reading, because the students did not know how to say the word in English. Writing, the students have difficulty in writing or pronouncing the words.

B. Suggestion

1. For the English teacher
