CHAPTER II

LITERATURE REVIEW

A. Theoretical Framework

1. Teacher Creativity

a. Definition of Teacher Creativity

In educational institutions, creativity is very important for an teacher, because with creativity an teacher can create a very pleasant learning atmosphere so as to foster motivation, demand and even student achievement in learning.

The word "creativity" is basically taken from the word creative which means to make, create, design, write or create something new. Creativity comes from English creativity which means a person's ability to create, design, essay or even create something new and useful to solve the problems at hand. Meanwhile, creativity in the KBBI is the ability to create, inventiveness or about being creative.¹

According to Reisman, creativity is a skill that assumes personal motivation and good luck, where through creativity can be found several important points, namely creativity must see, observe and analyze things in different ways, creativity makes connections between experiences or observed phenomena, creativity finds hidden patterns from the experience to develop those patterns, and creativity relies on previously accepted rules.²

Abu Dharin in Monawati, also defined that creativity is a competence possessed to be able to produce new and varied things, so that it is expected to be

able to apply both in art, science, and other fields, and is also expected to be accepted by certain groups or can be utilized by many person. Meanwhile, according to Monawati, creativity is a process that produces or creates new things in the form of real works, ideas, products and can be used in solving a problem.³

According to Sudarma creativity can also be interpreted as follows:

- Creativity is defined as an energy or strength that exists within a person.
 This power can encourage someone to do something in many ways in order to produce the best.
- 2) Creativity is defined as a process, where in creativity many stages are carried out including being able to process information, act and create something new.
- 3) Creativity is also defined as a product, namely the result of one's creativity can be judged by others.
- 4) Creativity is a person. In the sense of person, it means that creativity is seen from individuals who have intelligence both in terms of attitudes, habits and actions in creating something new.⁴

In addition, according to Mednick in B. Suryosubroto define creativity, creativity in the forming of associaties elements into new combination which either meet specified requirinment or some ways useful. The more mutually remote the elements of the new combination, the more creative the process

The definition of creativity is also found in Al-qur'an, one of definition is

Meaning: Explanations (miracles) and books. And We have sent down to you the Quran, that you may explain to mankind what has been revealed to them and that they may think.⁶

In the verse above, it is explained that the apostle was sent with statements in the form of miracles that prove their prophethood and apostolate. And some of them carry books containing laws, advice, and rules that guide the lives of their people. And sent down az-zikr, namely the Qur'an, to explain to mankind what has been revealed to them in the form of guidance and guidance in the book so that they know and follow the right path and so that they think about things that become lessons for them. Their benefit in this world and the hereafter. In this verse, it is clear that we are required to think, this is in accordance with the notion of creativity which comes from the ideas that someone thinks about which then he tries and strives to make these ideas come true with his abilities. Allah has sent down the Qur'an which will help humans develop their knowledge which greatly facilitates humans in living their lives in the world, and we should realize that by looking around us like objects.⁷

Therefore, there needs to be creativity in every individual, especially

teachers, where teachers will educate their students so that they can become creative individuals as well. Teachers should also be aware that technology has changed learning methods, from teacher-centered to student-centered. Therefore, as facilitators of student learning, teachers should support students in gathering information and using technology wisely to practice their language outside the classroom, for example; via mobile devices, where the WhatsApp application is also operated via mobile devices or handphone.⁸

A creative teacher is someone who is professional, who actively imitates their own creative involvement in the classroom and tries to involve it in their students. Creative teachers will strive to improve the well-being of their students, they see the development of creativity and originality as the hallmark of their teaching. ⁹ They will think and create extraordinary ideas before starting the lesson to achieve success in the teaching and learning process.

Based on the above understanding, it can be concluded that creativity is a person's competence or ability to create, create, work or design new things in the form of information, products, motivation and other things, which can be accepted and useful for many people. While teacher creativity is the competence possessed by teachers in teaching not only in mastering the material, but an teacher must also be able to be innovative, be creative and make combinations in the use of media, methods, strategies and a comfortable, unsaturated learning atmosphere and make it easier to understand lessons.

b. Creativity Standard

Teachers are one of the most important components of education, without teachers how can students receive knowledge and excel. This is how important the task of an teacher is, an teacher not only masters theories, but teachers must also have creativity. There are several standards of creativity that an teacher must have, including:

- a) Person, often said to be a creative personality.
 - 1) Have the ability to know the problem from all directions
 - 2) Have a great curiosity ambition.
 - 3) Can expose new experiences.
 - 4) Dare to challenge challenging tasks.
 - 5) Have a fairly broad insight.
 - 6) Appreciate the work of others.
- b) Process, everything that results from the process is considered a creative product. There are four stages of creativity, namely:
 - 1) The first stage is to find a problem in the activities carried out, this stage is also called the introduction stage.
- 2) The next stage is to prepare and collect all the information that causes problems in the activity, this stage is also called the preparation stage.
 - 3) The third stage is thinking about new ideas or ideas in solving problems. This stage is also known as Scientificization.
 - 4) The last stage is to test optimally according to reality, and this stage

is also called verification.

c) Products, namely the results or works created either in the form of objects or goods or ideas. The dimensions of the creativity product are described as follows "Creativity To Bring Something New Into Existence", must show two characteristics, namely first, unique, useful, latest, true and valuable, secondly, it must have heuristic properties, display methods that are still or have not been/rare done before.

Based on the explanation above, it can be concluded that there are three standards or criteria for creativity, namely the person related to a person's personality, then the process, namely the stages that must be passed from preparation to producing a new product. The point is that every individual actually has creativity, but the ability of creativity is different, and the things that are created are different according to the problems faced and how to respond and provide solutions to these problems.

The standards of creativity that must be owned by an teacher are:

1) An teacher must be able to plan a good teaching and learning process, starting from formulating learning objectives, collecting taught books, compiling taught material, determining methods, choosing appropriate learning media and using fun learning strategies to compiling

evaluations. ERA UTARA MEDAN

2) The ability of teachers in the implementation of the teaching and learning process. In teaching and learning activities, teachers are expected to be creative in opening lessons, delivering material to closing. The method used should not be monotonous, but must be varied, the strategies and

media used must be appropriate and attract the attention of students in learning.

c. Characteristic of Teacher Creativity

Education is very important for every individual, with education a person can master something that is useful to be a provision for his life both in this world and in the hereafter, from this it is necessary to realize how important good communication between teachers and students is. The communication in question is where teachers must be able to deliver more creative learning so that it helps students to more easily understand the subject matter.

Andi Yudha said that creative teachers have the characteristics of being flexible, optimistic, respectful, agile, humorous, inspiring, gentle, disciplined, responsive, empathetic, and friendly. One scientist named James D. Brown explained about the characteristics of Teacher Scholar including:

- 1) A teacher scholar must be able to display or reveal things that help students in learning.
- 2) Continue to involve students in all learning activities.
- 3) Have the ability to provide encouragement or motivation to students.
- 4) Have the ability to develop learning strategies.
- 5) Can create joyful and meaningful learning
- 6) Have the ability to combine in the learning process.

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- 7) Creating and developing learning media that are in accordance with the material, interesting and applicable.
- 8) Able to vary and develop teaching materials.

9) Able to produce new innovations in learning. 10

From some of these characteristics, the point is that creative teachers will try to improve the welfare of their students, they see the development of creativity and originality as the hallmark of their teaching. A creative teacher is someone who is useful to anyone around him, especially to his students.

Based on the explanation above, it can be concluded that creative teachers have characteristics including, liking challenges, appreciating the work of students, having noble character, being able to combine, vary, choose media and strategies and many other characteristics.

d. Factors Affecting Teacher Creativity

Creating creativity is not easy if it is not supported by the things needed for creativity. From this, an teacher who wants to create creativity must be supported by several factors including:

- A working atmosphere that helps teachers develop and improve their knowledge and skills in carrying out their duties.
- 2) Educational personnel work well with each other in solving problems that occur.
- 3) Provide motivation as enthusiasm and appreciation for positive efforts UNIVERSITAS ISLAM NEGERI for teachers with the aim of improving student learning outcomes.
- 4) Giving trust to teachers to improve themselves and demonstrate their work and creative ideas.
- 5) Give great researcherity or responsibility to teachers in completing

- tasks and problems that occur.
- 6) Provide opportunities for teachers to be able to design and formulate policies related to the implementation of education in school institutions, especially with regard to student learning achievements. ¹¹

2. WhatsApp

a. Definition of WhatsApp

The meaning of the word "WhatsApp" comes from the English phrase "What's up?" which means "What's new?". WhatsApp is an instant messaging application that provides users, using an Internet connection, with access to exchange images, videos, and audio, or text messages. ¹² Awada said that WhatsApp is a free application that can be used on various types of mobile phones and allows people to talk and send messages and pictures over Wi-Fi, 3G and 2G networks. ¹³ Meanwhile, according to Allagui WhatsApp is a cross-platform instant messaging service for selected smartphones and medium-sized phones that use the internet to connect to the network in order to communicate with other people. This is one of the mobile apps that teachers can use in their classrooms. This app allows its users to send messages to their family, friends and colleagues for free. While WhatsApp messages can be simple text with shortcuts, there is no limit to the number of words. Message. WhatsApp allows users to chat with up to

transferring text messages and group chats, users can also send and receive voice or video conversations, send and download files.¹⁴

Ennoch Sindang in Jumiatmoko define that WhatsApp is an internet-based application that makes it easy for users to share various kinds of content according to its supporting features and can also be used to communicate with the help of internet services. ¹⁵ Meanwhile, Anwar and Riadi define WhatsApp as a chat application that can send text messages, images, sounds, locations and videos to other people using any type of smartphone. ¹⁶

Barhoumi also define WhatsApp as a good online learning application when used in an integrated strategy so that learning activities through WhatsApp bring benefits to student achievement in WhatsApp-based learning.¹⁷ While Bouhnik and Deshen define that WhatsApp as a smartphone application that is used to send messages instantly. New the most important benefit of the WhatsApp application is its ability to improve communication to a group of people or groups. WhatsApp communication improves interaction between teachers and high school students. Bouhnik and Deshen also emphasized that WhatsApp groups used by teachers and students can increase interaction between fellow members in the classroom, promote a social atmosphere, foster dialogue, increase sharing among

Based on the above understanding, it can be concluded that the WhatsApp application is an application that uses the internet with 3G/4G and wifi connections, to make it easier for a person or group of people to communicate or exchange information, whether Pesan Teks, images, videos, video calls, documents and other other.

b. History of WhatsApp

WhatsApp is a communication application created by Jan Koum who is from Ukraine and Brian Acton who is a partner of Yahoo in 2009. At the beginning of the creation of WhatsApp there were only a few users and the application often crashed which made this very difficult for Jan Koum. However, with Apple's push notifications, the launch of WhatsApp became an increasing success. In addition, the app offers a unique type of instant messaging that allows users to log in with their phone number. For this reason, applications are growing exponentially. In February 2014, Koum sold WhatsApp to Facebook for \$19 million.

One of the reasons why WhatsApp is so widely used is because it offers more features than most texting apps. It uses your phone's Wi-Fi or cellular connection to facilitate messaging and voice calls. It supports sending free messages and calls worldwide, even if the user is not in the same country. You can share your location, share your status, share contacts, set custom wallpapers, email chat history, and simultaneously share messages with multiple contacts.

WhatsApp is now the leading mobile messaging app in 112 countries and dominates in India, Germany, Russia and the UK. It is currently used by more than 1 billion users worldwide.¹⁹

c. Function of WhatsApp

WhatsApp has various functions, besides being able to send messages or chat in groups, it can also share photos, videos, and documents. However, the use of social media is not used as a literacy medium by students. Students only spend time with WhatsApp as a social media that is limited to sending messages, photos and documents that do not contain literacy at all.

In addition, WhatsApp has several features, namely:

- 1) Can send text messages
- 2) Can send photos from the camera or from the gallery
- 3) Can send any number of videos
- 4) Can send office files or other data
- 5) Voice calling, including sending your voice message that the recipient can listen to at any time.
- 6) Can share location using GPS
- 7) Sending a contact card
- 8) Support multiple emoticons like stickers

The use of WhatsApp as one of the most widely used social media by the community, especially in the world of education, because in general students from both formal and non-formal education during this pandemic have used this

application in their daily activities both inside and outside school. Teachers and students do not experience many difficulties in the online learning process provided by the teacher through this WhatsApp application compared to using other applications.²⁰

d. Advantages of WhatsApp

After describing the meaning of WhatsApp above, the researcher gets several advantages from WhatsApp, including:

- 1) Facilitate the delivery of information via chat or status, without having to write a letter and send it to the destination address.
- WhatsApp application can form groups. The groups that are created can vary according to the needs and objectives of the groups created. Adhi Susilo explained that WhatsApp Messenger Group is a discussion group service that can accommodate up to 256 participants. A very large number and can be collected in just one application. Its members can share discussions and information online with each other. So basically in the WhatsApp application you can create several groups, and each group can accommodate up to 256 participants. This also makes it easier for teachers to create groups according to class or according to subjects in school.
- 3) Facilitate the exchange of information with various features including using text (text), voice messages, pictures, videos. for the world of education helps teachers to be creative in providing

- subject matter to participants by using various features of the WhatsAppp application.
- 4) This application is also environmentally friendly, there is no need to waste or use paper in providing documents.
- 5) If you want to see someone you want to communicate with, the WhatsApp application provides a video call feature.
- 6) Communicate long distances at low cost without having to spend a lot of money.

e. Disadvantages of WhatsApp

All applications on the device, must have advantages and disadvantages, no application provides perfect features, this is also included in the WhatsApp application. There are several disadvantages of using WhatsApp including:

- 1) The WhatsApp application must be used online, if the application is offline then all information cannot be accessed. Therefore, internet data packages must always be active.
- 2) Use WhatsApp if too many files are sent or files are incoming, it will make the storage full and make the connection slow.
- 3) Too many messages in the group will make it difficult to find important UNIVERSITAS ISLAM NEGERI information that has been embedded, due to group chat.

3. English

Language is a medium of communication for everyone to express their goals and objectives, every nation has its own language. Therefore, it is impossible for a person to interact with the interlocutor if both parties do not

understand each other's language conveyed by both of them. This diversity of language is part of the signs of Allah's power, explained in the Qur'an Surah Ar-Rum: 22

By mastering foreign language, especially languages that are widely used by non-Muslims, we can have dialogue, discuss and convey Islamic da'wah that is rahmatan lil 'alamin, if it is sincerely intended to preach Islam, God willing, learning foreign languages is included in the Sunnah of the Prophet.

Learning English is very important for those of us who live in this millennial era, because English has been used in various countries and in various sectors. So that we can communicate with other people and understand other languages from the objects we know. interviews, speech acts, etc.²⁶ Speaking skill is the most important skill for all learners who want to learn English to improve their career, improve business, build self-confidence level, get better job opportunities, make public speeches, attend interviews, participate in debates and group discussions, give presentation and so on.²⁷

According to Daulay Speaking generally denotes "oral communication" is defined as an action involving two or more people interlocutor or listener. Where they respond to each other through reactions to what they hear. Therefore, speaking and listening are one unit. They cannot be separated each other. Speaking and listening are built together to create competence in English communication. When speaking, one's fluency and memory will increase and will improve. In addition, through speaking English skills can develop motivation to find new words and dialects.²⁸

b. Writing

Writing is expressing language that is conveyed in the form of letters, symbols, or words that have the main purpose of communicating. Written using tools such as paints, pencils, pens, typewriters, and computers. Writing can be written anywhere, one can even express his writing on a cave wall, a piece of paper such as an advertisement text, or a computer screen. There are various styles

and registers of English. Some of the texts are descriptions, narratives, newspaper articles, dialogues; and others.

According to Hague writing is the process of creating, organizing, writing and polishing. In the first step of the process, you create the idea, in the second step, you organize the idea. In the third step, you write a draft, in the last step you beautify the draft by editing it and creating results based on your ideas. Writing is an activity that allows students to be able to create their imaginary world from their own designs. Writing as one of the four language skills is considered a difficult skill because the writer has to balance several aspects of writing such as content, organization, purpose, vocabulary, punctuation, and spelling.²⁹

c. Reading

A process of interaction between the reader and the material in which all schematic knowledge interacts with all social and contextual factors of the reader is called reading. Reading skills is a person's ability to read, understand, and interpret written words on article pages or other reading material. Reading skills can only be developed through continuous reading. Instilling a culture or habit of reading is a hobby. According to Andersonin Kartika reading is a basic life skills, it is the foundation for a child's success in school. ³⁰ Reading skills are receptive skills to understand printed words such as understanding main ideas, understanding sequences, understanding certain details, making inferences, and

making predictions in a second and foreign language. And also researcher can say that reading is the ability to understand written English as presented in textbooks, newspapers, magazines, menus, massages and academic materials.³¹

d. Listening

Listening is part of four Basic English language skills. It seems like the other skills such as writing, reading, and speaking. Listening skills are skills in receiving the transfer of images, impressions, thoughts, beliefs, attitudes and emotions from the speaker.³² Listening skills is a process in language skills that require practice using audio/technology.³³ Listening is the activity of paying attention to the speaker and trying to find meaning from something that is heard. Listening is the most important language skill and also a part of communication through listening we can share our ideas with other people.³⁴ One of the considered basic skills of speaking is listening, because without understanding the input at the right level, any learning cannot begin.

- 3. Wiji Lestari (2021), thesis entitled "Pemanfaatan WhatsApp Sebagai Media Pembelajaran dalam Jaringan Masa Pandemi Covid-19 Di Kelas VI Sekolah Dasar". Based on research conducted by Wiji Lestari, he found that teachers have used WhatsApp as a learning medium to support online learning activities by utilizing various available features such as photo, video, document and video call features.
