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

The purpose of this study is to describe students' mistakes in writing descriptive text, how the errors occur and why errors occur when writing. This study focuses on writing descriptive text for class IX students of Mts Ira Medan. The method in this research is descriptive qualitative. The steps of error analysis are making tests, collecting data, analyzing data, correcting, and making reports.
