



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**STATE INSTITUTE FOR ISLAMIC STUDIES

This Memorandum of Understanding serves as an agreement between both parties to cooperate in the following areas:

1. Exploring the potential for joint activities in Education and Training
2. Identifying opportunities for training professional staff members in customized training program arrangements on need basis
3. To identify opportunities for accreditation training and accreditation and certification of educational institutions
4. To identify opportunities for faculty and staff exchange
5. To identify opportunities for sharing of facilities and human resources

Agreed Strategies

The parties will cooperate, map and implement mutually beneficial activities and programs which may include:

1. Fellowship programs;
2. Skills training and development programs;
3. Consultancies and Technical Assistance on capacity building and training; and
4. Other innovative educational and training activities for human resources development.

Agreed Parameters

1. This document sets out an understanding that has been reached and as such is not intended to be legally enforceable.
2. Each party acknowledges that the other remains independent and that this understanding confers no rights unless by expressed agreement, and that each has external limits on the extent and nature of cooperation permitted between the parties.
3. The parties recognize that they are separate organizations and have their respective accountabilities and organizational policies and guidelines.
4. This understanding will be valid for two years from the date of signing; the duration may be extended by the parties prior to that date or ended by action of the parties.


