The sampling (purposive sampling) by the number of 34 students. Through limited test for 10 times it was effective and can improve students' career aspirations. It can be proved by an increasing of pre-test scores to the post-test on the scale of career aspirations generally of 32.97 points, or 36.23% and hypothesis testing of post-test results between the experimental and control groups which produced the value  $t = -3.174$  and had a chance of 0.003 . The value of 0.003 compared to T table 0.05,  $0.003 > 0.05$ . It means that it closed to 0; significant value. Therefore, it can be concluded that the  $H_0$  hypothesis is rejected. It showed that there was a significant difference between the average level of the career aspirations of the experimental group with the control one given no treatment.


